Included are PDFs of annual reports of the chief of coast artillery and chief of engineers; several board proceedings and reports; army directories; text books; tables of organization and equipment; WWII command histories; drill, field, training manuals and regulations; ordnance department documents; ordnance tables and compilations; and the ordnance gun and carriage cards.

These collections are available as PDF files on DVD. They include RCBs/RCWs; maps; annexes to defense projects; CD engineer notebooks; quartermaster building records; and aerial photos taken by the signal corps 1920-40. 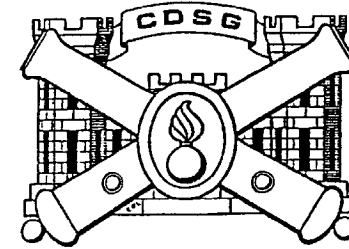

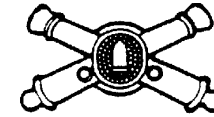

CDSG MEMBERSHIP FORM

The Coast Defense Study Group, Inc. (CDSG) is a tax-exempt corporation dedicated to study of seacoast fortifications. CDSG's purpose is to promote and encourage the study of coastal defenses, primarily but not exclusively those of the United States of America. The study of coast defenses and fortifications includes their history, architecture, technology, strategic and tactical employment and evolution. The primary goals of the CDSG are the following:

- * Educational study of coast defenses
- * Technical research and documentation of coast defenses
- * Preservation of coast defense sites, equipment and records for current and future generations
- * Accurate coast defense site interpretations
- * Assistance to groups interested in preservation and interpretation of coast defense sites
- * Charitable activities which promote the goals of the CDSG

The CDSG was officially founded in 1985 at Fort Monroe, Virginia and incorporated in 1993. The first "St. Babs" conference was held in 1978 to visit the harbor defenses of New York. Subsequent annual CDSG conferences have visited all the major former harbor defenses of continental United States, and the current schedule is revisiting those sites. The tours have been held to Bermuda (1990/98), Hawaii (1991), Corregidor (1991/96/01/06), Panama (1993), Victoria (1995), Halifax (1999), Vladivostok (2002) and Spain/Gibraltar (2005), Helsinki, Finland and St. Petersburg, Russia (2007).

Membership is open to any person or organization interested in the study or history of the coast defenses and fortifications. Membership in the CDSG will allow you to attend the annual conference, special tours and receive the CDSG's quarterly journal.

THE CDSG FUND

The Coast Defense Study Group, Inc. (CDSG) has established the **CDSG Fund** to accept tax deductible donations. This cross-country move allowed this rare 90-mm mount to be restored and viewed by the public. The **CDSG Fund** is working on similar projects, but donations from you are essential.

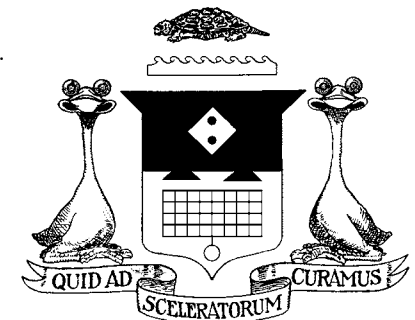
